Public Safety Information Sheet

Safety and Security procedures at Wisconsin Center District Facilities owners and operators of the Wisconsin Center, UW Milwaukee Panther Arena, and the Miller High Life Theatre.

The Wisconsin Center District (WCD) Public Safety Department is a 24 hour, 365 day a year operation. Each shift has a supervisor who is trained in CPR and Defibrillator use. The WCD facilities are patrolled 24 hours 365 days a year.

All WCD employees are trained on proper evacuation procedures. These procedures, along with other emergency quick reaction procedures are listed on the attached Ready Reference document. Please take time to review the plans listed in the document.

In case of injury or illness, the Milwaukee Fire Department has an immediate response time to the WCD. To reach immediate medical, security, or safety assistance, you can dial 6165 from any house phone and provide the information to the dispatcher that answers the call. The dispatcher will obtain all necessary information and forward that information to the appropriate response agency. **DO NOT HANG THE PHONE UP UNTIL THE DISPATCHER INSTRUCTS YOU TO.**

Additional information on WCD emergency plans or other assistance can be found by dialing 6165 from any house phone.

Injuries or other occurrences involving attendees shall be reported to the WCD Public Safety Department by dialing 6165 from any house phone or by reporting it to any WCD employee.
